Update

The representatives from the 4 North Burlington United Churches – Nelson, Tansley, Lowville and St. Stephen that have been meeting for the last 18 months, with input from our recent group session with the respective boards, have continued to move forward. We now have a name for ourselves as a group of churches who are forming one church body as well as a vision statement. Both are noted above.

While no one yet knows what form this vision will take, we do know that this journey will require patience, understanding and divine guidance to try to find the best path for all involved.

Ongoing, we want to engage more congregational members to gather ideas and suggestions about how we can continue to achieve our vision. To that end, we are planning a half day workshop on Sat. Feb 25, 2017. It will be held at St. John’s Anglican Church on Dundas St. (across the highway from Nelson UC) and we have engaged a facilitator from Edge to guide us. More details about times will be available at a later date.

The ongoing Visioning Group will be comprised of a minimum of 3 members from each church (one of whom must be on the Council or Board) and all 3 ministers. Church members from any of the churches are welcome. The co-chairs of this group are Dale Martin from Tansley and Heather McGavin from St. Stephen.
